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Boondocks Alumni Shooting Club Terms & Conditions

Individual \$240, Family \$360

The following Terms and Conditions shall apply to Alumni Shooting Club enrollments issued by Boondocks Firearms Training Academy™ ("BFTA") for **Boondocks Alumni Shooting Club** ("Club"). Any reference to "you" or "your" shall refer to the person identified on the Application and Agreement (the "Application").

- 1. REQUIREMENTS. No Application for the Club shall be effective until: (a) the Application is completed and signed by you and submitted to BFTA with the required Fee, (b) you and family member/s are 18 years of age, (c) you are eligible to purchase a handgun (provides evidence that you are qualified to purchase a handgun Mississippi Firearm Permit, law enforcement ID), (d) you have completed at least a one-day live-fire class at BFTA (i.e. Basic Pistol MEP, Defensive Carbine, Defensive Shotgun etc.).
- **2. DESIGNATION:** If you have completed at least one one-day handgun class at BFTA (i.e. Basic Pistol MEP), the Member is rated at as "BASIC". If the Member has taken any advanced pistol class at Boondocks (i.e. Defensive Carry, Defensive Pistol I) that includes drawing from the holster and clearing jams or malfunctions, then that individual is rated "ADVANCED". Only ADVANCED Members may draw from the holster.
- 3. CHANGES IN THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS. BFTA reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to discontinue operation of the Club or to modify these Terms and Conditions of Enrollment in the Club, to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of the Club facilities in any manner whatsoever and to any person whomsoever, to add, issue, modify, or terminate any category of enrollment, to discontinue operation of the Club facilities, to limit use of the Club facilities, and to make any changes to the club benefits at any time. Such changes shall be effective on the date such revised Terms and Conditions of Membership are posted to the BFTA web-site or as otherwise communicated to the Members. Any such changes shall be binding on you on the effective date of the change.
- **4. PAYMENTS.** Annual fees shall be due and payable on anniversary date of Club Member's Membership Enrollment. The initial fees shall be as set forth on the Application. The annual membership fees may be increased at any time upon 30 days prior written notice to you by BFTA. BFTA may also change any other charges applicable to services provided to you at any time. Annual fees are required to be paid by credit card, personal check or cash.
- **5. REFUNDS.** Alumni Club purchases are non-refundable with the exception of member relocation or other life changing event. Refunds will be pro-rated and issued in the form of a Boondocks Gift Card.
- **6. RANGE SAFETY RULES.** BFTA Range Safety Rules, contained within this document, are available to Members at all times and are posted on the web-site as well as on Waverly

Range ("Alumni Range"). You acknowledge and agree to follow the Rules at all times. Any violation of the "Go Home" Rules shall be grounds for immediate suspension or termination of all or a portion of your Membership privileges.

7. USE OF CLUB FACILITIES. BFTA agrees to provide access to Alumni Range and its facilities. You acknowledge and agree that the Club and Range are not provided for the exclusive use of the Club Members. From time to time, BFTA may host events during and after normal business hours that may result in the temporary closure of Alumni Range. All such events and any scheduled maintenance requiring closure of the Club or Alumni Range shall be communicated to the Members in advance by e-mail and/or by posting on the Club bulletin board on BFTA website calendar.

8. MISCELLANEOUS.

- A. It is the policy of BFTA to accept applications from any individual that meets the requirements established from time to time by BFTA, without regard to race, color, creed, gender, religion or national origin, nor shall such matters ever be made a condition of Membership.
- B. The Membership is personal to the Primary Member and may not be transferred or assigned at any time to any other person.
- C. You acknowledge that there have been no promises, warranties or representations, express or implied, pertaining directly or indirectly to the Membership which are not contained herein or on the <u>BFTA web site</u>.

9. RANGE SAFETY RULES.

- A. ALWAYS TREAT ALL FIREARMS AS IF THEY ARE LOADED.
- B. ALWAYS KEEP THE FIREARM'S MUZZLE POINTED DOWN RANGE/BERM.
- C. ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF OF THE TRIGGER UNTIL READY TO SHOOT.
- D. NEVER POINT YOUR FIREARM AT ANYTHING YOU ARE NOT WILLING TO DESTROY.

10. BOONDOCKS RANGE SAFETY RULES.

- A. ALWAYS treat all firearms as if they are loaded.
- B. ALWAYS keep the firearm's muzzle pointed down range/berm.
- C. ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- D. NEVER point your firearm at anything you are not willing to destroy.
- E. Eye MUST be worn at all times.
- F. Hearing Protection MUST be worn while the range is hot.
- G. A brimmed hat or visor is required while on the range.
- H. Only load/handle your firearm when you are on the firing line and the range is hot.
- I. If you would like to move to another position/set of targets, ask the Range Safety Officer (RSO) first.
- J. If you drop anything at the firing line, do not pick it up or try to catch it; wait until the line is called "SAFE" to "RECOVER YOUR GEAR" or the RSO helps you.
- K. If you have problems or need help while on the firing line, keep your finger off trigger, lower your firearm to the low ready position or place it on the table; the RSO will come assist you.

- L. No cell phone or camera usage on the range; keep electronics stored in your bag not on your person.
- M. If you have any medical conditions, please advise RSO.

11. HOLSTER USAGE

- A. Holsters must be strong side only, holsters may be inside the waistband or outside the waistband but must stay open for safe re-holstering only holsters made of Kydex, polymer or good leather may be used. No appendix, cross draw, purse, or shoulder holsters may be used.
- B. Holsters are to be model specific, made for that make and model of firearm.
- C. NO Blackhawk SERPA holsters are allowed.
- D. NO worn out, flimsy or nylon holsters should be used.
- E. Trays are provided and should be used is this case.
- F. RSO will make this call on the safety of holsters being used.

12. DRAWING FROM HOLSTERS

- A. Only RED ticket holder alumni may draw from holsters and must meet with holster safety rules listed above.
- B. No fast drawing or using a shot timer, these rules apply to speed reloads as well.
- C. All drawing from a holster or reloading must be in a smooth and controlled manner.
- D. Range Officer may inspect holsters and any other gear used on the range and review safe usage. They
- E. Can allow or not allow holsters or any other gear deemed unsafe.

13. GO HOME RULES.

- A. No GUN HANDLING allowed in the BFTA Pro Shop or parking lot.
- B. Any NEGLIGENT DISCHARGE where your bullet does not impact a safety berm.
- C. If you pull your gun OUT OF THE HOLSTER while you are not on the firing line.
- D. If you are on the firing line and you pull your gun OUT OF THE HOLSTER while a range safety officer or alumni is down range.
- E. Your firearm DISCHARGES while you are attempting to RE-HOLSTER or your firearm discharges and the BULLET IMPACTS within 2 YARDS of yourself, an instructor or another
- F. You DROP a loaded firearm or a loaded firearm FALLS out of your holster.
- G. Repeated infractions of UNSAFE MUZZLING, TRIGGER FINGER issues, or UNSAFE RE-HOLSTERING.
- H. A violation of any of the GO HOME RULES will result in a removal from the Alumni Range.
